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"Advances in Latent Variables: Methods, Models and Applications"

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The book, belonging to the series “[Studies in Theoretical and Applied Statistics](#) – Selected Papers of the Statistical Societies”, will present a peer-reviewed selection of contributions on relevant topics organized by the editors on the occasion of the [SIS 2013 Statistical Conferences](#) "Advances in Latent Variables. Methods, Models and Applications", held at the Department of Economics and Management of the University of Brescia in June 19-21, 2013.

The focus of the book is on advances in statistical methods for analyses with latent variables. In fact, in the last years, an increasing interest has been devoted to this broad research area from both a theoretical and an applied point of view, as the statistical latent variable approach allows to effectively model complex real-life phenomena in a wide range of research fields.

A major goal of the volume is to bring together articles written by statisticians from different research fields, which hopefully will present different approaches and experiences related to the analysis of unobservable variables and the study of the relationships among them.

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
